- ✚ **OSH Hiring Event:** This hiring event was a HUGE success. Over 600 job seekers came to apply for a job; 364 were Job Link clients, 210 were not (some didn't say). Most people heard about the event through the Press Democrat (219), followed by family and friends (102). OSH representatives were very pleased with the outcome and called 300 job seekers for second interviews. A BIG thank you to everybody who participated and the staff that stayed behind at Job Link to keep serving our clients!
- ✚ **New hiring event:** WIS (Washington Inventory Services) is having a hiring event at Job Link on August 3, 2009. They are hiring for 30 inventory positions, which will pay \$8.15/hour. More details will follow soon.
