- # **Employer Services:** The Leadership Subcommittee will be developing a charter for a new workgroup to address employers' services in our new demand driven system. Membership will include individuals from the Employment Team and the Marketing Committee. The subcommittee's goal is to improve Job Link's connection with local businesses in order to better address their needs.
- # **Job Start:** All materials and equipment will be moved from Job Start very soon. The majority will come to Job Link, including several computers that will be placed in the old Resource Center. As you can all imagine this will create some turmoil at Job Link. Just keep in mind: *New Program Under Construction!*
- # **Procedure development:** All the work from the Welcome Team and the Employment/Skills Team is being transformed into formal written procedures. Their policy recommendations are moving forward to the Leadership Team. In addition, management is looking at all the MOUs for partner agencies.
